Connecting Families to Developmental Services

Help Me Grow connects families and children with developmental or behavioral concerns to resources in the community. By calling the toll free number, **1.866.GROW.025**, families, service providers and professionals have a single point of entry into developmental services for children, birth through five years of age.

The four program components:

- **Making the Connection.** Care Coordinators at 2-1-1 Orange County with support from Community Liaisons provide intake, triage, referral & connection to developmental services.
- **Building the Network.** Community Liaisons develop ongoing relationships with programs in the community and support the maintenance of an updated resource inventory.
- **Educating Providers.** Team members educate professionals about the importance of developmental surveillance and screening while promoting access to developmental services through Help Me Grow. A developmental screening and monitoring program is available to families and providers.
- **Identifying Gaps and Barriers.** Data is collected and analyzed to document and identify needs to more effectively connect families to community resources.
