<b>What services will my child get?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>♥ These programs are like health insurance. They offer most kinds of health services.</li> <li>♥ They offer preventive check-ups, immunizations (shots), sick care, specialty care, and prescriptions.</li> <li>♥ Some also cover hospital stays, dental and vision care, mental health and other services.</li> </ul>					<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>♥ These programs are not like health insurance. They only cover some basic health needs like preventive check-ups and needed follow-ups. All give immunizations (shots). Some provide care for sick children.</li> </ul>		
<b>How much will it cost?</b>	♥ No monthly cost, no co-payments.	♥ \$4-\$27 per family monthly. ♥ \$5 co-payment for some services.	♥ \$35 monthly per child for a maximum of 3 children; no cost for additional children ♥ \$5 to \$25 for the services.	♥ \$0 to \$35 monthly per child in the family ♥ \$5-\$25 for the services ♥ \$10 application fee.	♥ First year, 2% of family income before taxes ♥ Second year – \$50 - \$100	♥ Free check-ups, immunizations and some related treatment.	♥ Free check-ups, immunizations and some related treatment. ♥ \$5 for sick care visits.	♥ Low cost or free.
